The concealment (or stashing) of contraband poses a significant safety risk in mental health environments.

Medication is sometimes concealed in an attempt to evade treatment, or to pass to other patients which may compromise recovery plans.


Sharp objects may also be concealed in connection with self-harm or to use as a weapon to harm others.

Staff are also at risk of harm from sharp objects when conducting contraband searches which often require them to run a hand along the gaps around the seat cushion of a chair or sofa.

We designed Coda with a generous 1.6 inches space between cushions, eliminating the usual tight spaces which pose a concealment risk, making the inspection process safer for staff.
